

ORDINANCE NO. 1027

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE CITY OF EDWARDSVILLE, KANSAS (“CODE”), CHAPTER 13 - UTILITIES AND REPEALING ALL OTHER ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the City of Edwardsville, Kansas:

Section 1. Code section 13.02.043 Delinquency; lien for unpaid charges (a) shall be amended to read as follows:

(a) Solid Waste service charges shall be a debt due the city. A penalty fee as provided in the fee schedule found in the appendix of this code shall be charged if the billing is not paid within 30 days of the date the charge is due. If this debt is not paid on its due date, it shall be deemed delinquent and may be recovered by commencing the necessary civil action, including but not limited to the use of a third-party collection agency, in the name of the city against the property owner, the occupant of the premises, the person charged, or any or all of them.


Section 2. Code section 13.03.048 Delinquency; lien for unpaid charges (a) shall be amended to read as follows:

(a) The sewer maintenance service charges shall be a debt due the city. A penalty fee shall be provided in the fee schedule found in the appendix of this code and shall be charged if the billing is not paid within 30 days of the date the charge is due. If this debt is not paid on its due date, it shall be deemed delinquent and may be recovered by commencing the necessary civil action, including but not limited to the use of a third-party collection agency, in the name of the city against the property owner, the occupant of the premises, the person charged, or any or all of them.

Section 3. All other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect after its passage and publication as required by law.
