

ORDINANCE NO. 1042

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE 4.03 - SALE OF CEREAL MALT BEVERAGE AND ALHCOHOLIC LIQUOR AND REPEALING ALL OTHER ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Kansas State Legislature has amended the State's liquor laws to allow for Sunday sales of alcoholic liquor and cereal malt beverages to begin as early as 9:00 a.m.; and

WHEREAS, the City Code of the City of Edwardsville, Kansas currently only allows for the sale of off-premise cereal malt beverages between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 12:00 a.m. Monday through Saturday and Sundays (except Easter Sunday), noon to 8:00 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, the City Code of the City of Edwardsville, Kansas currently only allows for the sale of alcoholic liquor between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday and Sunday, noon to 8:00 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, the City of Edwardsville desires to have its Municipal Code be consistent with Kansas statutes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF EDWARDSVILLE, KANSAS:

Section 1. Section 4.03.037 (B)(ii) of the Code of the City of Edwardsville shall be amended to read as follows:

(ii) Every Sunday, except Easter Sunday, between nine (9:00) a.m. and eight (8:00) p.m.


Section 2. Section 4.03.064 (a) of the Code of the City of Edwardsville shall be amended to read as follows:

(a) The sale of alcoholic liquor at retail within the City shall be between the hours of nine (9:00) a.m. and eleven (11:00) p.m. Monday through Sunday

Section 3. All other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force after its publication as required by law and the required 60-day petition period has elapsed.

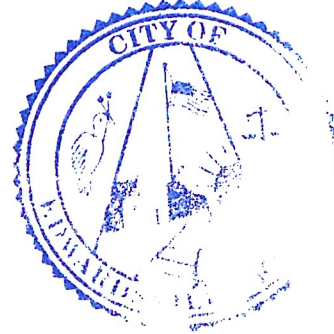
